



HABITAT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM MEETING MINUTES

Conference Call

June 13, 2018

8:00AM

Introductions: Members introduced themselves as they joined the call: DWM Bailey Franklin/CPW, Mary Taylor/BLM, Jim Brennan/livestock grower, Rich Parr/sportsperson and Admin. Samantha Sorensen/CPW.

Budget Report: Samantha had a budget report on hand but it was never discussed.

New Business: Dunham Water Well: Bailey explained that an old well on Becky Dunham's farm had collapsed and they've been hauling in water for the livestock ever since. Travis Day said they can drill right next to the old one. Mary asked if deer and elk would benefit. Bailey pointed out that mule deer most definitely will since the Dunham's farm falls within critical habitat for mule deer. Some antelope and elk will also benefit from the water source. Butch and Lenny gave their support and proxy vote to Bailey. The committee approved \$1,950.00 for the project. Sam said she would speak with Pat about State Council funding for the well.

Samantha mentioned that project paperwork had been coming in for a lot of projects, though she wasn't sure if the Josephine Basin Water project would get finished in time. Bailey echoed that the Halandras water project might not get done either.
