



HABITAT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM MEETING MINUTES

May 9, 2019

Introductions: Members introduced themselves as they joined the call: Scot Doderer/Livestock Grower, DWM Darren Chacon/CPW, Hilary Boyd/BLM, (proxy) Jim Nieslanik/Livestock Grower and Admin. Samantha Sorensen/CPW. **Guests on the call:** Joe Hood, DWM Dan Cacho/CPW.

New Business: Hood Ranch Vegetation Management Amendment: Joe explained that he thought a chipper might expedite the completion of his project. Quotes to rent a chipper were anywhere from \$3,000-\$5,000 per week. Hilary referenced Phil's email where he suggested the chipped material not be piled deeper than 3" but Hilary felt no more than 8" would suffice. Darren didn't think Joe would do anything detrimental to his project. The committee approved Joe's original proposal on 3/14/2019 for \$4,970.00 and felt comfortable approving his amended proposal for \$7,470.00. Darren asked Joe to get with Samantha about a purchase order.

FY20 Fence and Herbicide Vouchers: The committee approved the standard amount for vouchers in FY20; \$11,200 for fence and \$10,000.00 for herbicide.

Scot and Hilary explained they may have a hydroaxe project on West Elk Ridge to bring to the committee. A site tour will be conducted first; Dan thought it might be beneficial for Travis ByBee and Devin Duval to attend.
